TCFFB Coaches, Parents & Families,

As we head into the playoffs, we know emotions will be high as we cheer on our young athletes. These are exciting moments, and our players have worked hard to compete at this level. However, we must all remember one important message:

We must control our emotions and never allow our emotions to control us.

The energy and conduct of our coaches will directly impact the behavior of our parents and spectators. Coaches set the tone from the sideline, and TCFFB expects all coaches, parents, and players to represent our league with class, respect, and sportsmanship.

Our officiating staff has been instructed to address issues early and immediately. Any escalated behavior, unsportsmanlike conduct, taunting, arguing, or inappropriate sideline behavior may result in penalties and/or removal from the facility.

Please review the following playoff expectations:

Coaches' Conduct

Coaches are allowed to cheer and encourage their players from the sideline, not from the field. Any loud or overt cheering must be a brief "heat of the moment" reaction and must dissolve immediately. ***Coaches are expected to remain composed and help keep the game environment under control.***

Parent & Spectator Conduct

Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their own parents and spectators. If a parent or spectator is asked to leave the property, ***the game will not continue until that individual has completely left the facility.***

Sideline Access

Board members will be walking the fields throughout the playoffs checking sideline badges and monitoring conduct. ***Only authorized coaches with TCFFB-issued badges will be allowed on the team sideline.***
